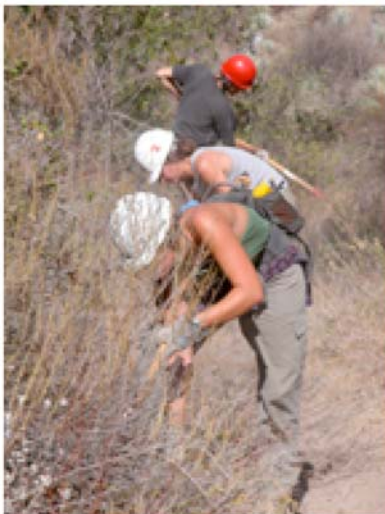


BLUE CANYON/COTTAM TRAIL MAINTENANCE PROJECT

One of Santa Barbara's hidden jewels, the Blue Canyon Trail leads along the Santa Ynez Fault down to the picturesque Cottam meadows and then up via a connector to Forbush Flats. The upper trailhead is located along East Camino Cielo and is a popular day hike and overnight camping area as well as one of the area's best mountain biking routes. We'll be working the connector leading from Forbush Flats down to Cottam. Please join us as we celebrate the 19th annual Trail Days and rebuild one of our area's best backcountry trails.



- Date of Project: Saturday November 15
- Start time: 7:45 A.M. for juice, coffee and rolls; 8:15 A.M. carpooling up to the trailhead
- Location: Meet at the Santa Barbara Mission
- What to Wear: Long pants, gloves, sturdy shoes and a safety or bike helmet are recommended. We supply all the tools.
- What to Bring: Water, lunch and sunscreen.
- Directions: Meet in the side parking area at the Mission at 7:45 A.M. To meet us at the trailhead, take Gibraltar Road to the crest, turn east and drive 4 miles to the Cold Springs trailhead.
- BBQ After: Join us for a BBQ at the trailhead afterwards.
