Trail Day this Saturday. Plans were discussed.
Raffle prize- mountainbike volunteers' names will be added to raffle for bike frame. Drawing later in the year.

Trail user education - Chris is looking for LPFA committee members to join him in Trail Education project: trail signs top and bottom of trails. Sam and Dave will help.

Bike etiquette stickers - we will give them to bike shops to install on new bikes. Sample sticker design approved. John M. has letter to shops asking for donations to get trail ed projects started. Approved.
